RESULTS
 The results that are achieved are from the SFD activity (4000000920): 23,250 persons gained access to improved water and sanitation and became able to practice good behavior. This achievement was reached through completing 1,569 rooftop cisterns, 4 communal cisterns and 1,673 latrines. Regarding the absence of results on the number of people living in open defecation free communities: The indicator is a measure of behavioral change, an assessment of this change will be done upon closure of this activity. The results will be presented in the final report. It is expected that the target will be achieved.

Reasons for result achieved.	Part of the results are retrieved from a report that is based on the first months of the project.
